

PUBLIC NOTICE

TEMPORARY LAND CLOSURE

Effective

January 5, at 2 PM - January 6, 2018 at 10 PM

and

February 2, at 2 PM - February 4, 2018 at 2 AM

The following special regulations are in effect in the areas of the Parker 250 and Parker 425 Off-Road Races:

1. Being present on or driving on the designated race course or the adjacent lands is prohibited. All spectators must stay within the designated spectator areas.
2. Vehicle parking or stopping is allowed only in the designated spectator areas.
3. Camping is allowed only in the designated spectator areas.
4. Discharge of firearms is prohibited.
5. Possession or use of any fireworks is prohibited.
6. Cutting or collecting firewood of any kind, including dead and down wood or other vegetative material is prohibited.
7. Operating any Off-road vehicle (as defined by 43 CFR 8340.0-7(a)) is prohibited.
8. Operating any vehicle in the area of the closure or on roads within the event area at a speed of more than 35 miles per hour.
9. Failing to obey any official sign posted by the BLM, La Paz County, or the race promoter is prohibited.
10. Parking any vehicle in violation of posted restrictions or in such a manner as to obstruct or impede normal or emergency traffic movement is prohibited.
11. Failing to obey any person authorized to direct traffic or control access to event area including law enforcement officers, BLM officials, and designated race officials is prohibited.
12. Failing to observe spectator area quiet hours of 10 p.m. to 6 a.m. is prohibited
13. Campsites or race viewing sites must be kept free of trash and litter.
14. All pets must be restrained by a leash of not more than 6 feet in length.
15. Reserving spectator area sites is prohibited.
